### 1-14 Funadeuki Boat Boarding Area

Enjoy fresh caught seafood on an uninhabited island after seeing the traditional fishing methods of the Yatsushiro Sea. Season is from April to the end of November.

### 4 Yatsushiro Castle Ruins

A castle built by Masakata Kato, it received special protection, keeping it safe when the shogunate issued the one castle per province law. With its stone walls made of limestone, it is also called the "White Heron" Castle.



### 3 Future Forest Museum

A museum with a novel design. With exhibits like the Matsui Library Collection, it's an introduction to the history and culture of Yatsushiro.



### 5 Monument to the Kappa's Visit

The area where 9,000 Kappa came ashore, crossing over from the Ancient Chinese continent.

### "Mizushima", National Site of Scenic Beauty

### 10 "Mizushima", National Site of Scenic Beauty

A small island. Called "Mizushima, island of wonder" in Manyoshu, it's an important historical site in Manyo history.



### 9 Yatsushiro Nationwide Fireworks Competition (Kumagawa River and Green Space)

Held every year on the third Saturday of October, it's the only nationwide fireworks competition in Western Japan.

### 2 "Shohinken", National Site of Scenic Beauty

Built in the first year of Genroku(1688) by the lord of Yatsushiro Castle, Naoyuki Matsui, even now it tells of the prosperity of the Yatsushiro castle town.



### 6 Yatsushiro Yokatoko Product Hall

Has both restaurants where creative cuisine can be eaten and a specialty products corner, where things like fresh-picked vegetables, processed foods and souvenirs can be purchased.



### 7 Matsunaka Nobuhiko Sports Museum

A museum for Matsunaka Nobuhiko, who hails from Yatsushiro City.



### 8 Yatsushiro Shrine (Myoken Gu)

One of Kyushu's three big festivals, the "Yatsushiro Myoken-sai" takes place on November 23rd and has been nationally designated as an important intangible folk cultural asset.
